GPA, language proficiency etc.)</b>	The official TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean Language) score is NOT required, but, if possible, we prefer prospective students to have at least basic or intermediate communicative skills un Korean, because the medium of language for most of the courses here at BUFS is Korean. Korean skill courses focusing on communicative skills are offered for the international students and there are also several content-based courses in English, but the majority of courses are delivered in Korean.
<b>19. In case of language proficiency requirements, have our exchange students mandatory to provide any kind of language certification? If yes, which one?</b>	There is no required language certification, BUT since most of the courses are offered in Korean, the students need to have a basic skill in Korean language.
<b>20. Main language of instruction:</b>	Korean
<b>21. Others languages of instruction:</b>	A few classes are offered in English, but it is very limited. The foreign language-related departments offer skill-based courses in the target languages. However, the majority of courses are offered in Korean.
<b>22. Which department and lessons can our exchange students access to? Can they take classes from different departments?</b>	The exchange students will be assigned in the Division of International Studies (Korean Language & Culture Track) but will be placed in the courses “exclusively for the international students”. Courses may include Korean functional, skill-based courses to improve students’ communicative competence in Korean Language, and liberal arts courses. This means that exchange students will NOT be placed together in the same classes with the local Korean students majoring in Korean Language and Literature. However, for international students whose Korean language competency is above par, he/she can choose to take content-based courses with the local Korean students.
<b>23. Are there any departments/courses not open to our exchange students?</b>	Technically, undergraduate level courses are open, although there may be some exception, to all international students, on condition that the exchange students have a Korean language proficiency to compete with the local Korean students.
<b>24. Could you explain us your grading system in full?</b>	The duration of “one semester” is usually 15 weeks, and the number of credits assigned for each courses is “usually” based on the number of class hours per week for the duration of one semester. For example, if you are taking a 3 credit course, this means the class on average meets 3 hours per week for 15 weeks. Therefore, “a 3 credit course” is equivalent of about 45 hours.

Although the NHISK is mandatory, only after students' Alien Registration Cards (ARC) are issued by the Immigration office of Korea will students have access to the NHISK plan. For this reason, it is strongly encouraged that the student purchase a private insurance (with medical evacuation and repatriation coverage included) in addition to the said NHIS plan so that there is no medical coverage gap.
