24. Could you explain us your grading system in full?	The Georgian grading system uses a 100-point scale, 51 being the minimum grade for passing. Each numerical grade corresponds to a qualitative grade as follows: Fail (FX, F): 0- 50; Sufficient (E) – 51 - 60; Satisfactory (D) – 61 - 70; Good (C) – 71 – 80; Very Good (B) – 81 - 90, Excellent (A) – 91 - 100.

30. What is the average living cost?	If you are planning to live in Tbilisi, you should be prepared to have budgeted between 350 – 400 euros. Daily living costs: 1. Lunch – 6.30 euros 2. Monthly Public Transport Unlimited – 12 euros 3. Broadband Internet Connection – 11 euros 4. Monthly Fitness Club Membership – 42 euros Public transportation in Tbilisi is efficient and cheap, especially for students. There are some discounts as well.

Health insurance is a fundamental requirement in order to obtain a Permit of Stay once in Georgia. So we suggest take out an international insurance policy which covers all medical costs in the case of medical treatment or hospital stays.

<p>34. Visa information</p>	<p>Depending on the purpose of your travel to Georgia, there are different categories of visas that will apply to the occasion. Whether you are planning to go on a visit, study or work and reside there permanently, you will have to apply for a different Georgian Visa, accordingly. The fastest and easiest way to check whether you need a visa to enter and/or stay in Georgia, or transit the territory of Georgia is to click on “DO I NEED VISA” button and process step by step with simple online application: https://www.geoconsul.gov.ge/en/visaInformation?process=2</p> <p>To obtain a Georgian visa a person may submit the documentation as through <i>E-Application System</i> as via <i>e-Visa Portal</i> depending on the purpose of the travel. The documentation required for application differs depending on which category of visa (and status of residence) the applicant wishes.</p> <p>E-VISA PORTAL – the easiest way to get permit of entry into and travel within the territory of Georgia for the purpose of short stay. Prospective travelers have a possibility to obtain the short-term visa <i>without visiting Georgian Embassy or Consular Office</i>. A visa application shall be submitted through the e-VISA PORTAL only by <i>a person staying abroad</i> if the issuance of a C category short-term electronic visa by the Ministry is required. In the course of filling in a visa application through the e-VISA PORTAL, a message will be sent to the e-mail address indicated in the visa application to subsequently confirm the e-mail address and to ensure payment of the state duty. The e-mail address shall be confirmed within 1 (one) hour after it is sent, otherwise the visa application will be cancelled. The state duty shall be paid within 5 (five) hours after the message received on the e-mail address is confirmed.</p> <p>E-APPLICATION SYSTEM – through this system a person is eligible to apply for any category of visa. The system allows to submit e-application for booking time for submission of visa application at the appropriate consular office. Unlike the e-VISA PORTAL, after the visa application is submitted through E-Application System, hard copies of the signed visa application and all other documents necessary to issue a visa shall be submitted to the visa issuing authority by submitting them directly to the visa issuing authority or another body authorised to accept documents; and in the case of diplomatic and special visas – by directly submitting them to the visa issuing authority, or by post.
