34. Visa information	Depending on the purpose of your travel to Georgia, there are different categories of visas that will apply to the occasion. Whether you are planning to go on a visit, study or work and reside there permanently, you will have to apply for a different Georgian Visa, accordingly. The fastest and easiest way to check whether you need a visa to enter and/or stay in Georgia, or transit the territory of Georgia is to click on "DO I NEED VISA" button and process step by step with simple <b>online application</b> : https://www.geoconsul.gov.ge/en/visaInformation?process=2 To obtain a Georgian visa a person may submit the documentation as through <i>E-Application System</i> as via <i>e-Visa Portal</i> depending on the purpose of the travel. The documentation required for application differs depending on which category of visa (and status of residence) the applicant wishes. <b>E-VISA PORTAL</b> – the easiest way to get permit of entry into and travel within the territory of Georgia for the purpose of short stay. Prospective travelers have a possibility to obtain the short-term visa <i>without visiting Georgian Embassy or Consular Office</i> . A visa application shall be submitted through the e-VISA PORTAL only by <i>a person staying abroad</i> if the issuance of a C category short-term electronic visa by the Ministry is required. In the course of filling in a visa application through the e-VISA PORTAL, a message will be sent to the e-mail address indicated in the visa application to subsequently confirm the e-mail address and to ensure payment of the state duty.
