The 100-point grading scale is adopted at NCU. The full marks for both undergraduate students and postgraduate students are 100. The passing grade for undergraduate students is 60, and postgraduate students 70. Except for special subjects, which have a Pass (P) / Fail (F) grading system approved by the Department/Institute Curriculum Committee and the Academic Affairs Committee, grades of all other subjects must be rendered in integers.
