Emanuela Stefani is since 1997 the Director of the Conference of Italian University Rectors (CRUI) and since 2001 Director of Fondazione CRUI.

Since 2011 until 2014, she was Director of the QUACING Agency, the accreditation body for Italian Engineering Programmes.

She has taken part in and managed several activities concerning the university system, particularly in the field of quality assessment and university teaching.

At present she:

- manages and coordinates CRUI and Fondazione CRUI activities.
- is a member of the Assessment Units of many Italian Universities.
- is a consultant of Universities, Regions and Ministers on assessment, project designing and university management.

She is the coordinator of the first experimental project of the Common Assessment Framework (CAF) in the University system; she is a member of the Council of EUA – European Universities Association, of the Scientific Council of AVEPRO, the Quality Assurance Agency of the Ecclesiastic Faculties of the Holy See, and of the National Commission for the Promotion of the Italian Language abroad, established at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. She seats in the Editorial Committee of some scientific reviews. She seats also in several international Italian university's bodies of evaluation.

She was the institutional coordinator of ALFA III "CID" project (Conocimiento, Inclusion, Desarrollo) led by Fondazione CRUI, 2011 -2014 which involved 16 partners from Latin America and Caribbean (LAC) countries and 4 from Europe. The Project was a systemic action of social cohesion, inclusion and local development. It aimed to improve access to tertiary education of persons in situations of social disadvantage (women, adult people, and ethnic minorities).
