If you are a national of another country, you may require a visa for your Erasmus+ period - please ensure that you contact your local embassy or consulate of the country you will be visiting to find out if you need a visa and, if so, how and when you must apply for it. Please ensure that you apply for your visa in plenty of time before your Erasmus+ exchange or placement as applications may take several months to process. Normally, along with other documentation, you will be required to provide written confirmation of your acceptance from your host university or organisation, as well as proof of your start and end dates.
