In addition, "+" and "-" are used to further differentiate the student's performance with "+" indicating a superior performance in that letter grade, and "-" indicating a slightly weaker performance in that letter grade. A student will receive a grade of "F" if he/she fails to attend classes without officially withdrawing from the course.
