February 2023). For this reason, our Call AY 22/23 will unavoidably concern selection of outgoing students according to this calendar: this means that **just** for those Universities with the AY that starts with a spring semester (es. Spring 2022 + Fall 2022) we will necessarily have to consider the Fall 2022 and the Spring 2023 dates and related deadlines.*
