- Experience in teaching language classes and coordinating activities for groups.
- Ability to work in an international team.
- Kindness, openness and creativity.
- A drive to succeed and willingness to go the extra mile to achieve a goal.
- Good knowledge of Microsoft Office.
- Knowledge of Photoshop, Canva or other graphic design programs will be an advantage.
