Could you explain us your grading system in full?	<p>According to the Italian Grading System, Examinations are graded according to a scale ranging from 0 to 30, with 18 as a pass mark. A "cum laude" may be added to the highest grade (30; 30 e lode) as a mention of special distinction.</p> <p>So, for the rating system A(90-100), B(80-89), C(70-79), D(60-69) our marks from 30 to 25 fall in the range A-B; our marks from 24 to 21 fall in the range C; our marks from 20 to 18 fall in the range D.</p>

Have our exchange students to subscribe any kind of insurance that is mandatory for your university and/or for your country?	Health insurance is a fundamental requirement in order to obtain a Permit of Stay once in Italy. So we suggest take out an international insurance policy which covers all medical costs in the case of medical treatment or hospital stays (Please note: <i>papers of the health insurance had in the home country must bear the stamp of the Embassy/Consulate where the students address their Visa request: this in order to validate the Health Insurance.</i>

Visa information	<p>Students coming from a country not belonging to the European Union, must apply for a study visa before their arrival in Italy: they can visit this link (http://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home/en) in order to check out if they need to apply for a VISA.</p> <p>In order to apply for a VISA, students are required to make a pre-enrollment via University portal (https://www.universitaly.it).</p> <p>For the Italian law, those students with a VISA-type D over 90 days length</p>

	<p>(from 91 days on) should submit for the Residence Permit Request within 8 working days from their arrival in Italy.</p> <p>In order to apply Residence Permit, students need to bring with them:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - copy of the page of the passport with their personal data; - copy of the page of the passport with the VISA; - copy of their Health Insurance (if they don't get it before to leave from their home country, they can subscribe one on this website (https://www.waitaly.net/), cost is 71,00 euro up to 6 months (for Visa-type D up to 6 months) or 120,00 euro up to 1 year (for VISA-type D from 6 months up to one year length). <p>(PLEASE NOTE: <i>If this on-line procedure should be complicated to carry out, we suggest to subscribe an health insurance at their home country, provided that it covers also emergencies involving hospital admissions; papers of the health insurance had in the home country must bear the stamp of the Embassy/Consulate where the students address their Visa request: this in order to validate the Health Insurance).</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - copy of the exchange acceptance letter we will send them; - copy of a document where is indicated where they will live here in Siena (es. rental contract, payment receipt, booking confirmation etc.); - € 16,00 “ Marca da Bollo “ (a duty stamp that can be purchased at any Tobacconist) to be put on the residence permit application. <p>The residence permit application kit will be submit at the Post Office. There, they will be asked to pay only cash: € 30,00 to be paid for handing in the documents; € 70,46 to be paid as a tax to obtain the electronic residence permit.</p> <p>They will get a receipt from the Post Office where is indicated the appointment they have with the Police Station (Questura) to get the fingerprints. This appointment is mandatory. It is necessary to keep always the receipt with them and always show it together with their passport when requested.</p>
Timing of the acceptance letters release	Within about 5 working days after receiving the application form filled out.
Acceptance letter sending mode	By mail both to the student and his/her home University
Timing of transcript of records release	Late February after the end of 1 st semester exams period; early August after the end of 2 nd semester exams period
Transcript of records ending mode	You should request the transcript by mail to mobilitaextraue@unistrasi.it and we will send it both to the student and his home University
