<b>30. What is the average living cost?</b>	If you are planning to live in Tbilisi, you should be prepared to have budgeted between 350 – 400 euros. Daily living costs: 1. Lunch – 6.30 euros 2. Monthly Public Transport Unlimited – 12 euros 3. Broadband Internet Connection – 11 euros 4. Monthly Fitness Club Membership – 42 euros Public transportation in Tbilisi is efficient and cheap, especially for students. There are some discounts as well.

Have our exchange students to subscribe any kind of insurance that is mandatory for your university and/or for your country?</b>	Health insurance is a fundamental requirement in order to obtain a Permit of Stay once in Georgia. So we suggest take out an international insurance policy which covers all medical costs in the case of medical treatment or hospital stays.
<b>33. If yes, can you give us more details about it and the average cost?</b>	About 45 euros a month.

<p><b>34. Visa information</b></p>	<p>Depending on the purpose of your travel to Georgia, there are different categories of visas that will apply to the occasion. Whether you are planning to go on a visit, study or work and reside there permanently, you will have to apply for a different Georgian Visa, accordingly. The fastest and easiest way to check whether you need a visa to enter and/or stay in Georgia, or transit the territory of Georgia is to click on “DO I NEED VISA” button and process step by step with simple <b>online application</b>:  <a href="https://www.geoconsul.gov.ge/en/visaInformation?process=2">https://www.geoconsul.gov.ge/en/visaInformation?process=2</a></p> <p>To obtain a Georgian visa a person may submit the documentation as through <i>E-Application System</i> as via <i>e-Visa Portal</i> depending on the purpose of the travel. The documentation required for application differs depending on which category of visa (and status of residence) the applicant wishes.</p> <p><b>E-VISA PORTAL</b> – the easiest way to get permit of entry into and travel within the territory of Georgia for the purpose of short stay. Prospective travelers have a possibility to obtain the short-term visa <i>without visiting Georgian Embassy or Consular Office</i>. A visa application shall be submitted through the e-VISA PORTAL only by <i>a person staying abroad</i> if the issuance of a C category short-term electronic visa by the Ministry is required. In the course of filling in a visa application through the e-VISA PORTAL, a message will be sent to the e-mail address indicated in the visa application to subsequently confirm the e-mail address and to ensure payment of the state duty. The e-mail address shall be confirmed within 1 (one) hour after it is sent, otherwise the visa application will be cancelled. The state duty shall be paid within 5 (five) hours after the message received on the e-mail address is confirmed.</p> <p><b>E-APPLICATION SYSTEM</b> – through this system a person is eligible to apply for any category of visa. The system allows to submit e-application for booking time for submission of visa application at the appropriate consular office. Unlike the e-VISA PORTAL, after the visa application is submitted through E-Application System, hard copies of the signed visa application and all other documents necessary to issue a visa shall be submitted to the visa issuing authority by submitting them directly to the visa issuing authority or another body authorised to accept documents; and in the case of diplomatic and special visas – by directly submitting them to the visa issuing authority, or by post.
